

Fund Development Committee Meeting September 13, 2024

The Kellogg-Hubbard Fund Development Committee met in person at the library on Friday 9-13-24 at 11 a.m. Present were: Tai Nixa Peterson (Committee Chair), Colleen Beamish (Development Coordinator), Dan Groberg (Executive Director), Sarah Seidman, Sarah Swift, Craig Durham.

The agenda was approved by consent. Swift moved and Peterson seconded approval of the 5-9-24 meeting minutes. Motion carried.

Beamish reported that overall we are on track for fundraising this fiscal year. We were denied a NASA grant and will use feedback from them to reapply. The Dept. Of Libraries grant has yet to be received and a VCF grant for children's programming is in process. The book sale raised \$986 last month and there was a BOGO sale the first two weeks of September. The next book donation day will be Monday Oct. 21; volunteers will be needed.

The impact report has been sent to donors and hard copies will be available at the library. Groberg reported on the Amber McBride event Sept. 26 and said there will not be a reception held in conjunction with the free reading.

Rather than a mid-year fundraising appeal, the FDC will focus on the silent auction Sept. 26-Oct. 11 and the year-end appeal. Beamish noted that the library will bring back the popular solstice Giving Tree this winter.

The next meeting of the committee will be held Tuesday Oct. 1, 11-12 at the library, pending discussions on time/date change. The meeting adjourned at 11:58 a.m.
