



**Board of Trustees Meeting
Wednesday, April 15th, 2026**

1. The meeting was called to order at 5:00 PM by President Sarah Seidman. Present from the Board: Sarah Seidman, Bridget Asay, Katharine Burgess, Jeff Dean, Donna Lasick, Hunter Thiers, Stacy Brown, Sebastian Delgado, Michael Dougherty, Heidi Parker, and Sarah Swift. Present from the staff: Dan Groberg and Melissa Bunce. Absent from the Board: Edisa Gonzalez Revilla Muller, John Nelson, and Tai Nixa Peterson.

2-3. The agenda was approved by consent. On a motion by Swift, seconded by Brown the March 18th, 2026 meeting minutes were approved. The motion carried unanimously.

4. Executive Director’s Report. Groberg highlighted the library’s new partnership with the People’s Health and Wellness Clinic, announced the construction on the play structure would begin soon, and reported updates on both the Custodian and Director of Library Services positions. Additionally, the overheating project looks like it will be under budget.

6. Committee Reports:

- a. Board Development Committee: Parker reported final edits are being made to the board survey with a plan to release the application for new members in June.
- b. Executive Committee: Seidman reported that the Executive Committee plans to review policy updates in May.
- c. Finance Committee: Lasick announced that the finances are still looking good. The Finance Committee approved an increase in the library’s property insurance coverage to accurately cover current value of the library’s assets.
- d. Fund Development Committee: Brown let Board members know of volunteer opportunities for the May 1st Donor & Volunteer Appreciation event. Thiers reported that the first Friendraiser of the year was a success and Groberg added that it was a great opportunity to introduce more patrons to the innerworkings of the library.
